

From Athens Motorway

1. E92 motorway from Athens to Volos.
2. Take the Volos motorway exit (soon after Nea Anchialos Airport).
3. Follow main coast road for about 15 miles, through various villages.
4. Volos appears over the brow of the hill, with Mount Pelion and the villages beyond.
5. Go all the way down the hill to the end of the road.
6. You come to a T-junction at traffic lights. Turn right.
7. Follow the main traffic flow. Road bears left, passing the train station to your left (hard to spot).
8. You pass the port and harbour to your right (easy to spot!).
9. Bear right (with traffic) into one-way street – Iasonas (Jason).
10. At end of street the road bears left then right.
11. Pass the hospital and AB supermarket (nice food).
12. The road bears left. Fork right at traffic lights.
13. You are leaving Volos.
14. Pass the cement factory, pass Lidl (cheap food).
15. Keep on the main road, following signs to Argalasti, - through villages of Agria, Kato Lehonía, Malaki, Kato Gatzea.

If you wish to detour into the mountains for lunch...

After Kala Nera there is a left hand turn taking you up to Milies (about 7 windy kilometers up the hill). All the platia tavernas are lovely, eat where the most Greek people are eating. You can walk to Visitza from here, or drive the few kilometers and check it out. Return to the coast road to continue your journey.

16. Pass through Koropi.
17. The road leaves the coast and climbs through the countryside, - passing Affissos and Afetes.
18. A few kilometers after Afetes you reach a large road junction with overhead signs. Turn right to Argalasti (9km) - also signposted Milina, Lafkos, Promeri, Platania
19. Straight through Argalasti.
20. Bear right at the Metochi turn to Horto, Milina, and Trikeri.
21. Straight through Horto and Milina (our local village).
22. Pass Camping Olizon, Blue Bay Apartments.
23. The road bends left at the Sunsail Marina and Gibraltar Taverna. Marianthis Apartments are here.

We are on the other side of the bay, the little house in the middle (hard to spot), between the double roofed house and the two-storey house. Follow the road past Limani and Favios tavernas, around a couple more bends. As the road straightens out, look for the signs - Agios Andreas/Pelion Sail and Cycle banner/Penguinos Taverna/little chapel above the road/big chevron. Turn right to Agios Andreas. Follow the track down to the sea front (bear right). We are inside the blue fence! If you are walking to us then look for the beach path about 200 meters after Favios Taverna (by a mound of marble rock). Follow it down to the sea, across the beach and into the village. We are two doors after Penguinos Taverna.
